

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised that Albert Joe Standing, Jr. and Devine Rose Thomas have requested that their child Jalen Rose Standing's (dob: 3/28/99), enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so he may become eligible for enrollment with the Navajo Nation.

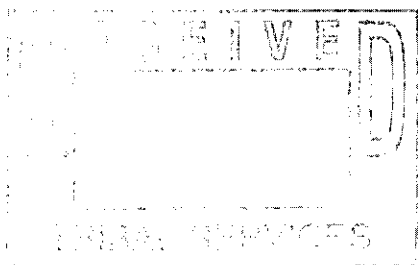
WHEREAS, Devine Rose Thomas signed the necessary documents of relinquishment of head rights for her child in the presence of a Notary Public on the 16th day of June, 2003, which is attached hereto; and Albert Joe Standing signed a notarized statement on June 30, 2003; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee approved this relinquishment request at their meeting on June 30, 2003.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the tribal relinquishment request for Jalen Rose Standing and his tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe is relinquished, along with any and all privileges accorded members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe such as, but not limited to: hunting, fishing, and recreational privileges upon the White Mountain Indian Reservation and upon Office of Vital Records' receipt of Proof of Enrollment with the Navajo Nation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Office of Vital Records to remove Jalen Rose Standing from the membership rolls of the White Mountain Apache Tribe upon verification of his enrollment with the Navajo Nation.

The foregoing resolution was on August 19, 2003, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article II, Section 2 and Article IV, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

**RELINQUISHMENT OF TRIBAL HEAD RIGHTS
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

I, Devine Rose Thomas the parent of our child who is an enrolled member of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, under the age of 15 years, do hereby, of my/our own free will, as an adult over the age of eighteen years, voluntarily and with full knowledge of making this decision, request the TRIBAL COUNCIL of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION, WHITERIVER, ARIZONA, to release my/our child from the Tribal Census Rolls of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to enable my/our child to enroll with the The Navajo Nation.

Further, I/WE understand that my/our child will no longer have fishing or hunting privileges on the FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION; No homesite or farmland assignments, or claim to have titles to any resources of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, or monies distributed pursuant to Judgement under the Indian Claims Commission Act. Further, that I must remove from the Fort Apache Indian Reservation within ninety (90) days after the Resolution date accepting my/our child's relinquishment, any livestock in said child's name. I further understand, however, that my child may reapply for enrollment in the White Mountain Apache Tribe upon reaching the age of eighteen (18), but that the Tribal Council has total, nonreviewable discretion to deny or grant said reapplication.
