## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- **WHEREAS**, the existing Fire Management building complex adjacent to the airport was built in 1972 from excess property; and
- WHEREAS, the existing Fire Management building provides 2300 square feet of office space and can accommodate 25-35 persons depending on the time of year. This calculates to 66-92 square feet per person which is less than the 100-120 square feet per person as required by the General Services Administration (GSA); and
- WHEREAS, about half of the facility is leased from the Tribe which has created unneeded complexities in maintenance, especially with heating, cooling and plumbing; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Fort Apache Agency. Branch of Forestry proposes the construction of a new facility across highway 73 just west of the existing facility as shown on the attached map; and
- WHEREAS, the proposed construction site is approximately 35 acres in size and is specifically located on the SE1/4 of the SE ½ of Section 14 and the N½ of Section 23, Township 5, North, Range 22 East of the Gila and Salt River Meridian, Navajo County, Arizona; and
- WHEREAS, the proposed new building complex will provide sufficient office space to coordinate wildland fire suppression activities, a dispatch office to support all dispatching activities, specified and sufficient areas for equipment and tool maintenance activities, housing for fire engines, training facilities, warehouse and fire cache and a kitchen and dining facility, and sufficient parking for employees and visitors; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council has approved the allocation of the land by Resolution No. 09-2003-213; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been notified that funds in the amount of \$1.7 million have been made available for the Construction of a Fire Management Building on the Fort Apache Reservation; and
- **WHEREAS**, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has approved a site for the location of the Fire Management Building.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the construction of the proposed BIA Fire Management Building complex.

- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes entering into a P.L. 93-638 Self-Determination agreement for the pre-planning, planning, design and construction of the Fire Management Building
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Tribe's Facility Management and Construction Group act in a capacity representing the Tribe in Construction management providing coordination of pre-planning, planning, design and construction of the Fire Management Building.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the BIA and WMAT enter into a Cooperative Agreement due to the various Federal entities performing and contributing to the work components to be accomplished
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the BIA, Fort Apache Agency seek additional funds needed for completion of the project without offset to Agency or Tribal budget.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 9, 2003</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>NINE</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (c), (f), (i), (s). (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


