

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** Linda and Joe Holden have come before the Tribal Council to describe the problems they have had in getting completion of their home by contractor Wayne Banashley, through a home construction loan provided by the Revolving Credit Program; and

**WHEREAS,** Mr. and Mrs. Holden report that the construction completion is more than a year overdue and the contractor has failed to abide by a revised completion date recently negotiated; and

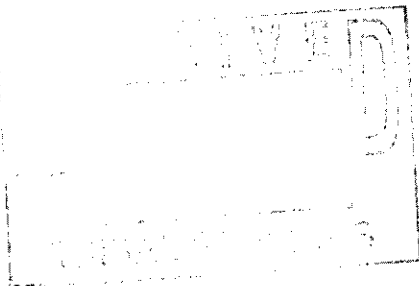
**WHEREAS,** because of the failures by the contractor to meet the requirements of the contract, the Holdens will seek a different contractor to complete the work and have asked for Council approval to utilize the Tribal construction program under the direction of Franklin Quintero; and

**WHEREAS,** Mr. Quintero has advised that he can do the work provided that the Tribal Council approves the project; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds that it would be appropriate for the Housing Construction Program to complete the work in order for the Holdens to finally have the completion of their new home.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Construction Program under the direction of Franklin Quintero to complete the remaining items needed for completion of the Holden home, subject to final agreement between the Holdens, the Revolving Credit Program, and Franklin Quintero, with the reasonable value of the final work paid from the remaining loan funds allocated by the Revolving Credit Program for the project.

The foregoing resolution was on OCTOBER 15, 2003 duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a). (i). (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
