FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS**, tribal members Eli Santiago and Kachiri Bead, seniors at East Fork Lutheran High School, have come before the Tribal Council this day to request financial assistance; and

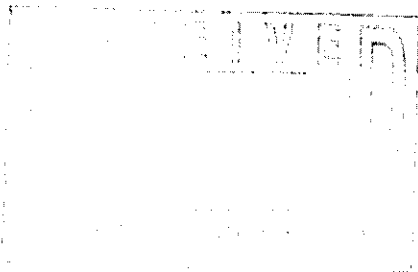
**WHEREAS**, Twenty-eight students and staff of the East Fork Lutheran High School will be traveling to California from December 4 – 6, 2003, to participate in the Great Western Shoot Out and to sing at St. Paul's in Riverside, California; and


**WHEREAS**, the trip will provide a tremendous learning experience for the students as they will experience new places and share ideas with schools from Phoenix, Seattle and Wildomar, California; further the students will speak about the reservation after church; and


**WHEREAS**, total cost of the trip is \$6,000 and the students and parents have raised \$3,500.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves to assist these students with \$3,000-\$1,500 from the Rodeo-Chediski Donation Account and \$1,500 from the tribal contributions account.

The foregoing resolution was on November 14, 2003, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
