- WHEREAS, the recreational-use seasons, prices, possession limits, prohibitions and Regulations are based on sound biological, business, and sustainable use principles; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council concludes that the Outdoor Recreation Regulations for 2004, as amended herein, be approved by the Tribal Council.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the attached Outdoor Recreation Regulations changes for 2004, as amended herein.
