

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

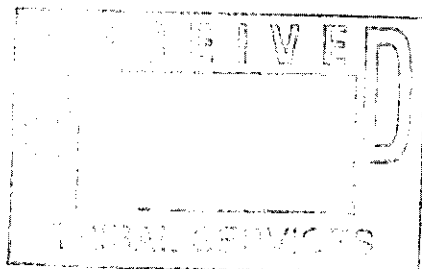
WHEREAS, Becky Ethelbah on behalf of Johns Hopkins University has approached the Tribal Council this date with a request that the Tribal Council approve the following manuscripts for publication: **1. Child Feeding Practices are Associated with Weight Status of American Indian Preschool Children; 2. High Prevalence of Overweight and Obesity in Apache Women and Preschool Children; 3. Formative Research and Stakeholder Participation in Intervention Development;** and

WHEREAS, the manuscripts examine separately: 1. The relationship between child and feeding practices and obesity among American Indian Preschool children; 2. To examine the prevalence of overweight and obesity in Apache pre-school aged children and their female care givers; 3. Presents a model for using formative research and stakeholder participation to develop a community-based dietary intervention targeting American Indians; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that it should grant approval to have the following three manuscripts published: **1. Child Feeding Practices are Associated with eight Status of American Indian Preschool Children; 2. High Prevalence of Overweight and Obesity in Apache Women and Preschool Children; 3. Formative Research and Stakeholder Participation in Intervention Development.**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves for publication the following three Johns Hopkins Manuscripts: **1. Child Feeding Practices are Associated with eight Status of American Indian Preschool Children; 2. High Prevalence of Overweight and Obesity in Apache Women and Preschool Children; 3. Formative Research and Stakeholder Participation in Intervention Development.**

The foregoing resolution was on January 16, 2004 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
