RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the family of Wendy Oliver is requesting Tribal Council permission for her burial on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the family has also requested assistance in the use of a backhoe; and

WHEREAS, Wendy Oliver was not a member of the Tribe; however, she lived on the reservation for many years.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the request of the Oliver family to allow Wendy Oliver to be buried in Whiteriver, Arizona on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 22, 2004</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
