

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has adopted workers compensation laws to provide for the treatment and compensation for employees injured at work; and

WHEREAS, Sunrise Park Ski Resort utilizes volunteer ski patrol members, in addition to compensated employees of the resort, to maintain the safe operations of the resort during the ski season; and

WHEREAS, Sunrise Park Ski Resort management would like to see that volunteer ski patrol members have workers compensation coverage during their hours of volunteer work on behalf of Sunrise Park Ski Resort; and

WHEREAS, under the law, volunteers generally are excluded from workers compensation coverage unless specifically authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, if authorized, the volunteers would receive coverage for medical claims arising because of the volunteer work activities and compensation for lost wages, but limited to a base wage amount of \$400.00 per month; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that workers compensation coverage for Sunrise Park Ski Resort volunteers serves the Tribe and the volunteers, and for that reason authorizes the coverage.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes workers compensation coverage for volunteer ski patrol members at Sunrise Park Ski Resort for activities directly related to the volunteer ski patrol work.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the base wage for the volunteer work shall be set at \$400.00 per month for the purpose of computing compensation benefits.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that any other volunteers are authorized to receive workers compensation coverage for volunteer work on behalf of the Tribe, they too shall be deemed to have the base salary of \$400.00 per month for the sole purpose of computing any applicable compensation benefits.

The foregoing resolution was on FEBRUARY 11, 2004 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by

the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
