

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Community of Cibecue and Indian Health Service facilities have experience unsafe flooding conditions due to Rodeo-Chediski Complex fire, in the vicinity of the CBQ Day School Wash; and

WHEREAS, Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) Route Cromwell Dr., has a undersized culvert in their road system. Post fire flooding has overflowed existing culvert and flooded into nearby Indian Health Service facilities downstream of culvert; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Transportation Committee has recommended a construction of a new box culvert to be constructed at the Day School Wash and placed on the BIA F.A.I.R. Chip Seal No. 2 CBQ Street Project to secure funding; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Transportation Coordinator has held a community meeting to gather input from community members on preferential recommendations as to the type of safety measures to be incorporated into project; and


WHEREAS, safety measures include: railed sidewalk on both sides of roadway, proper signage on south and north approaches, and guardrails.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby acknowledges the dire need for improvements of the Cibecue Day School Wash and request the construction of a box culvert be added on to the BIA F.A.I.R. Cibecue Chip Seal No. 2 project to secure funding.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that all safety measures requested by the community are addressed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs Regional Roads Department and included in the project.

The foregoing resolution was on March 18, 2004 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
