

**Resolution No. 04-2004-79**

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council is advised that the family of Leonard Bahe is requesting Tribal Council permission for his burial on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

**WHEREAS**, Leonard Bahe was not a member of the Tribe; however, his spouse and children are Tribal Members and he lived in Whiteriver, AZ for many years.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the request of the Bahe family to allow Leonard Bahe to be buried in Whiteriver, Arizona on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on April 8, 2004, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
