

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribe requires Police and Detention Policy and Procedure Manuals essential for the proper operation of the Tribe's Police and Detention Departments; and

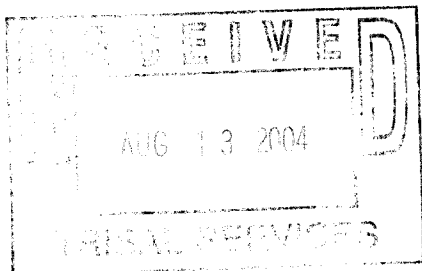
WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Police Department and Detention Department have developed Policy and Procedure Manuals that will enable efficient management of those departments; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Police Department and Detention Departments Policy and Procedure Manuals will be reviewed and updated annually as needed; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the manuals as presented this day and find them acceptable for implementation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the proposed Policy and Procedure Manual of the White Mountain Apache Tribe Police Department and White Mountain Apache Tribe Detention Department subject to annual reviews and updates as needed.

The foregoing resolution was on AUGUST 6, 2004 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
