

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that tribal member, Malye Malone, has requested Tribal Council approval for a new residential lease for her homesite located in the Whiteriver Community, as her prior residential lease expired November 28, 1988; and

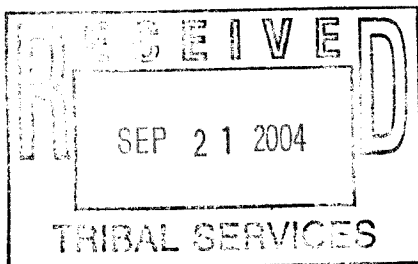
WHEREAS, Mrs. Malone has applied for assistance through the Weatherization Program to renovate her existing home, however, in order to complete her application, she must have a current residential lease with the Tribe for her home site; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered this request and concurs.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a residential lease to Mrs. Malye Malone, for her homesite located in the Whiteriver Community, for a period of 25-years, with an automatic 25-year renewal period.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman, and in his absence, the Vice Chairman or other duly authorized representative, to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the purpose of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on SEPTEMBER 8, 2004 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1(a), (c), (h), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
