

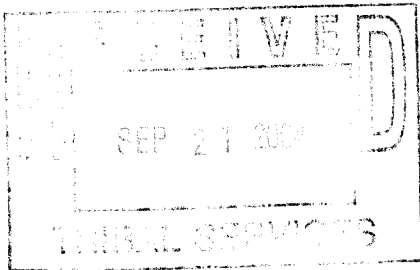
**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has received a request this day from Tribal Member Kenita Holden for assistance in obtaining a home where she can live; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds that Ms. Holden's situation requires that a home be located for her use as soon as possible and that the White Mountain Apache Tribe Housing Authority can assist Ms. Holden in locating such housing.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the White Mountain Apache Tribe Housing Authority, through its Director and Board Chairman, to assist Ms. Kenita Holden in locating a four bedroom home where she can live within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on SEPTEMBER 9, 2004 duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
