RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving Attorney Contract with Frank Freeman for the Position of Prosecutor for the White Mountain Apache Tribe)

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney has recommended to the Tribal Council that Frank Freeman be employed with the White Mountain Apache Tribe as Prosecutor; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney has provided the Tribal Council with a copy of Mr. Freeman's resume of education and work experience; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that Mr. Freeman is well qualified to act as Prosecutor for the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:
 - 1. Mr. Frank Freeman is hereby hired as the Prosecutor for the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
 - 2. The Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized to negotiate a contract with Mr. Freeman for such employment.
 - 3. The Tribal Chairman or, in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is further authorized to sign all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>JANUARY 12, 2005</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>TWO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
