

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Authorizing a Professional Services Agreement with Petra Sabori)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has authorized the Heritage Program to facilitate research, discussion, and policy development activities and initiatives in support of Inter-Apache efforts to achieve repatriation and Apache cultural protection goals; and

WHEREAS, the Heritage Program is nearing completion of a three-year program of consultations, museum visits, and documentation conducted in close cooperation with representatives of the San Carlos Apache Tribe, the Tonto Apache Tribe and the Yavapai-Apache Nation supported by a Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act grant administered by the National Park Service (grant 04-01-GP-294); and

WHEREAS, the final remaining element of the scope of work for the grant project involves development of a draft repatriation policy; and


WHEREAS, the National Park Service has reviewed and approved the Heritage Program proposal to engage Ms. Sabori as a paid consultant in support of the development of a draft *Repatriation Policy* and accompanying code; and

WHEREAS, the budget for Ms. Sabori's work is \$7,000.00.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes a Professional Services Agreement with Ms. Petra Sabori, which shall not exceed \$7,000.00, and authorizes the Chairman of the Tribal Council, or in his absence the Vice-Chairman, to execute all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it supports the ongoing code and policy development efforts by the Heritage Program and hereby requests the collaboration of all affected programs and offices in this work.

The foregoing resolution was on JANUARY 12, 2005 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
