WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving Manuscript to be Submitted for Publication)

WHEREAS, members of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe are duly elected representatives of the people and their respective districts; and among their many concerns are the health and well-being of its Tribal Members; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council supports carefully designed research projects to evaluate health problems which exist in the population and to develop appropriate interventions which seek to decrease or alleviate these problems; and


WHEREAS, Johns Hopkins is requesting permission to publish a manuscript titled *"Nasopharyngeal versus Oropharyngeal Sampling for Detection of Pneumococcal Carriage in Adults"* by Johns Hopkins personnel. This manuscript is based on data collected as part of the research protocol entitled **"A Double-Blinded, Controlled Study of the Efficacy, Immunogenicity, Safety and Tolerability, and Effectiveness of a Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine Containing Seven Serotypes (6B, 14, 19F, 23F, 18C, 4 and 9V) Compared to a Control Meningococcal C Vaccine in Navajo and Apache Indian Infants: (NNR-97-18)."** No personal identifiers are indicated or referenced and all information contained in the manuscript is submitted for the purpose of developing strategies designed to intervene and diminish the problems associated with pneumococcal disease; and

WHEREAS, the manuscript, if approved, will be submitted for publication in the **"Journal of Clinical Microbiology."**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby hereby approves that the manuscript be submitted for publication.

The foregoing resolution was on MARCH 4, 2005 duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (j), (k), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
