(To approve financial assistance for Novalita Johnson for her travel to Shemawa Indian School in Salem, Oregon)

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council this date was informed that tribal member Kayla Johnson's (who holds the title of Miss Shemawa) reign will be coming to a close; and
- WHEREAS, Novalita Johnson, Kayla's mother, will be traveling to Shemawa and has requested financial assistance for this purpose, as well as to provide gifts at the traditional pow-wow give away.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves \$1,000.00 to assist Novalita Johnson for her travel and to purchase gifts for the give away,
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that the \$1,000.00 be disbursed from the Tribal Contribution Account.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 13, 2005</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
