RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Emergency housing for Kenita Holden-Zospah and family)

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council was informed that tribal member Kenita Holden-Zospah has requested emergency housing due to deaths that occurred in her current home; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that Ms. Zospah's situation requires that a home be located for her use as soon as possible with the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority's assistance.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority to assist Ms. Kenita Holden-Zospah in locating emergency housing in a timely manner.

The foregoing resolution was on April 13, 2005, duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
