**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving \$6,000.00 for the Firefighter Memorial)

WHEREAS, Mr. Richard Genck has come before the Tribal Council this date to inform them of the firefighter memorial which will cost approximately \$17,000.00; and


WHEREAS, the memorial will be sculpted in the likeness of the late Rick Lupe and will be placed near the Larson Library in Pinetop, Arizona; and


WHEREAS, the purpose of the memorial is to create bond between communities and solidify relationship; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Genck states that \$6,000.00 is needed for the down payment.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a donation of \$6,000.00 for the Firefighter Memorial from the Rodeo-Chediski Contribution Account.

The foregoing resolution was on May 11, 2005, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
