RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Directing All Tribal Government Programs and Enterprises to Utilize Apache Owned Auto Body Services)

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Sections 1(b) and 1(i), inter alia, the Tribal Council has the power to negotiate, make and perform contracts, and manage economic affairs; and
- WHEREAS, N'Dee Auto Body ("NAB") made a presentation to the Council, seeking autobody repair work on the Tribe's government vehicles and towing services; and
- WHEREAS, NAB is located in Whiteriver, Arizona, and has a comprehensive autobody repair shop; and
- WHEREAS, NAB is owned and operated by members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that it is in the best interests of the Tribe that all government programs and enterprises of the Tribe buy goods and services provided by businesses owned and operated by members of the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that all tribal government programs and enterprises are hereby directed to utilize auto body repair and towing services provided by businesses owned and operated by members of the Tribe, such as N'Dee Auto Body.

The foregoing resolution was on MAY 11, 2005 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
