**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


(Mary Jo Stahl to meet with Tribal Council and to place a hold on Lou Ellen Greasewood's eviction status)


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council this date met in executive session with Lou Ellen Greasewood who resides at the Apache Ridge Town Homes; and

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that Mary Jo Stahl, Executive Director of CDC meet with them tomorrow, May 12, 2005 to discuss issues brought forth today.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it recommends to the CDC that Lou Ellen Greasewood's eviction be placed on hold until such time as the CDC can provide Ms. Greasewood an opportunity to appeal her eviction.

The foregoing resolution was on May 11, 2005, duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
