RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving publication of two manuscripts from the Johns Hopkins University related to the Apache Healthy Stores Study Program)

- WHEREAS, the Apache Healthy Stores Study Program of the Johns Hopkins University, has approached the Tribal Council this date with a request that the Tribal Council approve the following Apache Healthy Stores study manuscripts for publication: Process evaluation of a store-based environment obesity intervention on two American Indian Reservations, and Determinants of food purchasing and preparation in American Indian Households; and
- WHEREAS, the first manuscript examines the data collected at baseline for the Apache Healthy Stores study, and reports data collected from 11 intervention stores to document implementation; and
- WHEREAS, the second manuscript reports the results of the Customer Impact Questionnaire (CIQ) developed and tested to evaluate the impact the intervention, and documents the process of implementing the program; and
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves for publication by Johns Hopkins University of the following manuscripts: (1.) Process evaluation of a store-based environmental obesity intervention on two American Indian Reservations; and (2.) Determinants of food purchasing and preparation in American Indian Households.

The foregoing resolution was on May 12, 2005, duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
