RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Ordering Exclusion of Danny Dosela from the Fort Apache Indian Reservation)

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a), of the White Mountain Apache Constitution, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe, and to make decisions not inconsistent with or contrary to the Constitution; and
- WHEREAS, Chapter 5 of the White Mountain Government Code provides, "a non-member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe may be excluded or removed from the Fort Apache Indian Reservation after a hearing and the entry of an exclusion or removal order, or in cases involving a threat or danger to the public health, safety, or sovereignty of the White Mountain Apache Tribe or for violating Section 5.5, pending such a hearing, upon order of a Tribal Judge of the White Mountain Apache Tribe"; and
- WHEREAS, Fonda Siow, a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, presented a complaint against Danny Dosela, her ex-husband, to the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Dosela is a member of the San Carlos Apache Tribe and therefore a non-member within the meaning of 5.2(B) of the Government Code; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Siow presented testimony that Mr. Dosela lives with the aunt of their grandson and has contact with numerous dealers of illegal narcotics, which threatens the safety of the child; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Siow presented further testimony that she had filed a complaint for a restraining order against Mr. Dosela, and that he had violated the order; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Dosela has a prior federal criminal history, which originated in California; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that Mr. Dosela presents a threat to the welfare and safety of his grandson and Ms. Siow, that violation of the restraining order is grounds under Section 5.5(B)(2), and that these reported actions are grounds for an exclusion order against Mr. Dosela for his exclusion and to prohibit his entry onto the lands of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

Resolution No. <u>07-2005-170</u>

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

- 1. Danny Dosela presents a threat to the welfare and safety of his grandson and Fonda Siow such that he should be removed from the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.
- 2. The Tribal Attorney is directed to take legal action against Mr. Dosela, including a petition for an exclusion order from the White Mountain Apache Tribal Court to enforce the intent and terms of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 6, 2005</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>NINE</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
