

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving emergency housing for Yula Bonito)

WHEREAS, tribal member Yula Bonito has come before the Tribal Council this date; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Bonito has informed the Tribal Council of difficulties she encountered in obtaining a rental unit through Housing Authority; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Bonito needs to provide a stable home environment so that her children may be returned to her through Tribal Social Services; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that Ms. Bonito's situation requires that a home be located for her use as soon as possible with the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority to assist Ms. Yula Bonito in locating emergency housing as soon as possible.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 6, 2005</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
