RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Review names stemming from allegations of wrongful terminations in 1990)

- **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article I, Section 1(a); *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, tribal member Maggie Schaffer has come before the Tribal Council this date regarding her 1990 wrongful termination; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Schaffer states that she, along with Eunice (Tessay) Tessler and Manuelita Early, were unintentionally left off of Resolution No. 01-2004-05 for payment and should have been included; and
- WHEREAS, these individuals request that they be added so that they may receive payment; and
- WHEREAS, this day members of the Tribal Council state that the following individuals have also come forth or were also not included in Resolution No. 01-2004-05:

Randall DeClay, Sr., Christina DeClay, Pedro Johnson, Dorothy (Platt) Antonio, Pauline Platt, Vincent Craig, Mariddie Craig, Ray Ivans (deceased), Kirk Taylor, Brenda Altaha and Cyndy Harvey; and

- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds that this matter is long-standing and worthy of a full and fair investigation.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that an investigation be conducted by the Legal Department to verify the basis for the above claims.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 8, 2005</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for, <u>ZERO</u> against and <u>ONE</u> abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
