RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving a business license for Yolanda Joe)

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council, convening on July 6, 2005 for Tribal member requests, received Yolanda Joe's request for a small business license to operate a security business; and

WHEREAS, said business will be known as Blue Angel Security Enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the business will provide security services for local activities and events; and

WHERE AS, Ms. Joe is currently in the process of obtaining insurance for this business; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes the need for small business enterprises within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation to provide essential services and goods to residents of the Reservation to reduce the amount of travel, expense and inconveniences that Tribal members must incur by going off the reservation to obtain these services.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Treasurer to issue a business license to Yolanda Joe effective this day, for the purpose of operating a security business that will service residents of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 6, 2005</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
