

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Recommending that FATCO consider Mary Alice Harvey for employment subject to drug and alcohol testing and an available position)

- WHEREAS, Mary Alice Harvey this day did make a presentation to the Tribal Council, seeking employment under the Fort Apache Timber Company; and
- **WHEREAS,** Ms. Harvey was employed by FATCO as a breakdown hoist operator through to July 16, 2004; and
- **WHEREAS**, Ms. Harvey was laid off on July 16, 2004, due to a reduction in force action by the Executive Director of FATCO for budgetary reasons; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds that Ms. Harvey is suitable for employment subject to the availability of a position and FATCO's requirements for drug and alcohol testing for all of its employees.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Council hereby recommends to the Executive Director that FATCO consider Mary Alice Harvey for employment at FATCO, subject to the availability of a position and FATCO's requirements for drug and alcohol testing for all of its employees.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 4, 2005</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>TWO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
