**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Approval to grant non-member burial on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation)**

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council is advised that Bernadine Ethelbah is requesting Tribal Council permission for her mother, Polly Mouser, to be buried in Whiteriver, Arizona; and

**WHEREAS**, Polly Mouser was not a member of the Tribe; however, she has lived in Whiteriver for many years and has raised her family there.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the request by Bernadine Ethelbah and family members of the late Polly Mouser that she be buried in Whiteriver, Arizona on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on August 26, 2005, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
