

## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Reversal in part of Hon-Dah Grievance Committee recommendation Regarding Grievance of Roger Lupe, Jr.)

WHEREAS, Tribal member Roger Lupe, Jr., an employee of Hon-Dah Casino & Resort, an enterprise of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, has come before the Tribal Council this date to inform them of the grievance decision of the Hon-Dah Grievance Committee; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Lupe claims allegations of sexual harassment directed at him are incorrect and provided information to that effect, which was verified by Council Member DeClay, and requested that the recommendation be removed from his personnel record.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby removes the third recommendation of the Hon-Dah Grievance Committee from Roger Lupe, Jr.'s personnel record.

The foregoing resolution was on October 5, 2005, by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
