RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving Tribal Forestry BAER Program's Relocation to the Skills Development Center Owed by the Tribal Education Program)

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Forestry Burn Area Emergency Rehabilitation (BAER) program is currently housed in the BIA annex in Whiteriver; and
- WHEREAS, recently mold issues have made this facility uncomfortable to work in; and
- WHEREAS, as a Tribal program, the BAER project would be better served if they were in a Tribal facility with access to the internet and inter-tribal computer services; and
- WHEREAS, there are three offices in the Skills Development Center, a building owned by the Tribal Education Program, and the Education Program is supportive of allowing the BAER program to use this space and share building operation and maintenance expenses.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports the move of the Tribal Forestry BAER program to the available space in the Skills Center.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Education Department retains control of the building and premises.
