

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Approving Selection of Individuals for "HIP")

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised by the Housing Improvement Programs (HIP) Acting Coordinator, Albert Standing Sr., that selection of persons for the Fiscal Year 2005 Housing Improvement Program homes and the construction of said homes in compliance with the Housing Improvement Programs Grant be authorized; and
- WHEREAS, the HIP Acting Coordinator recommends that authorization be granted for construction of four (4) new homes for FY 2005 Housing Improvement Programs contract; and
- WHEREAS, the final selections are as follows: Fritzgerald Riley, Logan & Nora Penrod, Martha Antonio, and Melbourne Dazen, and Leon Zahgotah as an alternate; and
- WHEREAS, these applicants meet the requirements to receive assistance under the Housing Improvement Programs.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the selection of the above four (4) individuals named herein for the Housing Improvement Programs for the Fiscal Year 2005 is hereby approved.

The foregoing resolution was on October 6, 2005, duly adopted by a vote of FOUR for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (c), (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
