

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Granting Approval for the 2005 Apache Women's Conference)

- WHEREAS, section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe empowers the Tribal Council to act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe's Division of Health Programs is sponsoring the 2005 Apache Women's Conference to be held at the Hon-Dah Conference Center on October 18 & 19, 2005; and
- WHEREAS, this Conference will discuss women's issues and promote the health of native women and will be greatly appreciated by many of all ages; and
- WHEREAS, the Conference is an educational and informative two (2) day event, that will include a family wellness event, a morning fun walk/run and a special evening of native music and entertainment; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes that this two (2) day conference will be very beneficial and will greatly enhance the professional and personal enrichment of the Tribe's women members and employees.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the 2005 Apache Women's Conference to be held at the Hon-Dah Conference Center on October 18 & 19, 2005.

The foregoing resolution was on October 6, 2005, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
