

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Amending Resolution No. 10-2005-279 to authorize administrative leave for Apache Women's Conference)

WHEREAS, section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, members of the Tribal Council this date disagree with the absence of administrative leave in Resolution No. 10-2005-279; and

WHEREAS, Tribal Council finds that the intent of Resolution No. 10-2005-279 was to approve administrative leave for employees of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby amends Resolution No. 10-2005-279 to approve administrative leave for employees of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for attending the 2005 Apache Women's Conference.

The foregoing resolution was on October 25, 2005, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
