**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Review Paul White and Brenda Altaha – wrongful terminations in 1990)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article I, Section 1(a); inter alia, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, tribal members Paul White and Brenda Altaha have come before the Tribal Council this date regarding their 1990 wrongful terminations; and


**WHEREAS**, these individuals request that they also receive payment; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds that this matter is long-standing and worthy of a full and fair investigation.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that an investigation be conducted by the Legal Department to verify the basis for the above claims.

The foregoing resolution was on November 9, 2005, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 ((a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
