

## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Resignation of Chief of Police Reuben Kessay)

WHEREAS, Reuben Kessay, Chief of the White Mountain Apache Police Department (WMAPD), was directed in Resolution No. 10-2005-285 to submit the WMAPD operating budget on November 9, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the WMAPD operating budget was not presented as directed; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council recommends that Chief Reuben Kessay either resign or be terminated by the Chairman as stated in Resolution No. 10-2005-285.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that Chief Reuben Kessay either resign or be terminated by the Chairman effective immediately.

The foregoing resolution was on November 10, 2005, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for, ZERO against and ONE abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
