RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Authorizing Expenditure of \$2,000.00 for Lite Foot Concert in Cibecue)

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, inter alia, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, Council Member Henry did this day present a proposal to the Tribal Council to fund a concert by Lite Foot in Cibecue; and
- WHEREAS, Lite Foot is undertaking a nation wide tour, called "Reach the Rez Tour", which seeks to reach the youth on reservations with a strong, positive message against drugs and gangs while affirming Indian values, culture and belief, in a musical format that Indian youth understand; and
- WHEREAS, Council Member Henry estimates the costs associated with a concert in Cibecue to be no more than \$1,000; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that such a message is a benefit to the youth and the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that:

- 1. The Tribal Council supports a concert by Lite Foot in Cibecue and authorizes expenditure in the amount of \$1,000.00 for such purposes from the Rodeo-Chediski Fund account.
- 2. Council Member Henry shall be responsible for providing an accounting of all funds expended.

The foregoing resolution was on NOVEMBER 16, 2005, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (g), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
