**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Resolution Prohibiting Political Events and Events Hosted by, or on behalf of a Political Candidate, at the Hon-Dah Resort & Casino, Hotel and Conference Center)

WHEREAS, the Hon-Dah Resort & Casino, Hotel and Conference Center has always maintained political neutrality with regard to political candidates; and


WHEREAS, according to Hon-Dah Resort & Casino, Hotel and Conference Center, its political neutrality would be impaired if it was required to host political events or events sponsored by a political candidate during an election year; and


WHEREAS, in order to ensure that tribal elections are fairly and efficiently run, political events, or any events hosted by, or on behalf of political candidates, during an election year should be prohibited.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby prohibits the use of the Hon-Dah Resort & Casino, Hotel and Conference Center for political events.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Hon-Dah Resort & Casino, Hotel and Conference Center cannot be reserved or used for any events hosted by, or on behalf of a political candidate, during an election year.


The foregoing resolution was on January 3, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).






