

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Directing HIP Director to build a new home for Julia Mosby and directing the Executive Director of the WMAHA to give an emergency trailer to Julia Mosby)

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is empowered to act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, Julia Mosby is an elder of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and does not have a home of her own; and
- WHEREAS, the family members of Julia Mosby allege that she has been on a HIP list to receive a home since 1970; and
- WHEREAS, Julia Mosby is now requesting that the Tribal Council assist her in her efforts to have a home built; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority possesses certain emergency trailers that are not being utilized; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that it is in the Tribe's best interests to have HIP build a home for Julia Mosby during this fiscal year or the next fiscal year and that Julia Mosby be allowed to live in a WMAHA emergency trailer until such time that a HIP home is built for her.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the HIP Director to build a home for Julia Mosby by the end of the next fiscal year and directs the WMAHA to provide an emergency trailer to her until such time that a HIP home is built for her.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 4, 2006</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
