

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Directing the WMAHA and all applicable tribal programs and departments to coordinate in an effort to construct a home for Julia Mosby)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is empowered to act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Julia Mosby is an elder of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and does not have a home of her own; and

WHEREAS, the family members of Julia Mosby allege that she has been on a HIP list to receive a home since 1970; and

WHEREAS, Julia Mosby is now requesting that the Tribal Council assist her in her efforts to have a home built similar to a 2 bedroom home constructed by HIP; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that it is in the Tribe's best interests to have a 2 bedroom home (similar to those constructed by HIP) built for Julia Mosby and that the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority ("WMAHA"), the Tribe's Maintenance Department, the Elderly Program, NARCH, and all applicable tribal programs and departments should coordinate in an effort to construct said home.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the WMAHA, the Tribe's Maintenance Department, the Elderly Program, NARCH, and all applicable tribal programs and departments to coordinate in an effort to construct a 2 bedroom home (similar to those constructed by HIP) for Julia Mosby.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 4, 2006</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
