**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Adoption of Construction Worker Wage Scales)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article IV, Sections 1(a) and (b) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe, and to make all decisions not inconsistent with or contrary to this constitution and to negotiate, make and perform contracts and agreements of every description, not inconsistent with Federal law or the constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Tribal Employment Rights Ordinance (“TERO”)(WMAT Labor Code, Ordinance No. 203, enacted December 20, 1995), the Tribal Employment Rights Office may from time to time establish wage scales for construction workers; and

**WHEREAS**, all contractors employed within the Tribe’s lands of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation are required to adhere to the TERO, including paying members of the Tribe according to a wage scale for construction workers; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Employment Rights Office has produced Construction Worker Wage Scales for 2005, as attached and incorporated by this reference; and


**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds that the Construction Worker Wage Scale for 2005-2006 are in the best interest of the Tribe.


**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that:

1. The Construction Worker Wage Scale for 2005-2006, as attached and incorporated by this reference are hereby approved and adopted.
2. The Tribal Employment Rights Office is hereby directed to make the Construction Worker Wage Scales available to all firms bidding on construction projects within the lands of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on January 5, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
