

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

(Authorizing Supplemental FY 2005 Budget of \$5,400 for the N'Dee Bi Gowa Program)

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, inter alia, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- **WHEREAS**, by Resolution No. 10-2005-265 the Tribal Council did support and authorize the establishment of a homeless shelter program, known as *N'Dee Bi Gowa* Peoples Home; and
- WHEREAS, the program this day did present to the Tribal Council that its budget was short of funds in the amount of \$5,400.00; and
- WHEREAS, funds are available in the Rodeo-Chediski Account; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that supplemental funding of the program through FY 2006 is in the best interest of those who do not have a home or shelter, and the Tribe.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that:

- 1. A supplemental budget for the program described herein shall be funded through \$5,400.00 in funds transferred from the Rodeo-Chediski account

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 8, 2006</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
