**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving implementation of a universal suicide registry form entitled, "Celebrate Life Registry Form")


WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council supports carefully designed research projects to evaluate health problems which exist in the Tribe's population and to develop appropriate interventions which seek to decrease or alleviate these problems; and

WHEREAS, Johns Hopkins is requesting permission from the Tribe to implement a universal suicide registry form entitled "Celebrate Life Registry Form," which will bring together the Phoenix Area Indian Health Service pink form and the White Mountain Apache Tribe Suicide Prevention Coalitions' yellow form, and eliminate additional paperwork, but still incorporate all information needed.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the implementation and use of the universal suicide registry form.

The foregoing resolution was on February 8, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (j), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
