



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving the Outdoor Recreation Regulations for 2006, as amended)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Wildlife and Outdoor Recreation Division has come before the Tribal Council this date and requested approval of the Outdoor Recreation Regulations for 2006, copies of which are attached hereto; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed recommended changes to the Outdoor Recreation Regulations designed to provide sustainable use of Tribal recreational and natural resources; and


WHEREAS, the recreational-use seasons, prices, possession limits, prohibitions and regulations are based on sound biological, business, and sustainable use principles; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Outdoor Recreation Non-Member Regulations for 2006, as amended herein, be approved by the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the attached Outdoor Recreation Regulations for 2006, as amended herein.

The foregoing resolution was on FEBRUARY 8, 2006 duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (h), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

MAJOR REGULATION CHANGES FOR 2006

Outdoor Recreation Regulations

Outdoor Recreation (general) - per person -----\$3.00**

Change to read

Outdoor Recreation (general) - per vehicle (8 occupants) -----\$6.00

This is for individuals who drive off the main highway to do some sightseeing (picnic) and do not intend to camp or fish.

We have other changes, but are not major (mostly rewording of some of the regulations and season dates).
