Ordinance No. 227

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Approving Posting of Revised Criminal Code)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, Section 1(a), *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the power to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, the Prosecutor's Office and the Legal Department have this day proposed a Revised Criminal Code for the White Mountain Apache Tribe as Ordinance No. 227; and


**WHEREAS**, the proposed Criminal Code has been reviewed by the White Mountain Apache Police Department, the White Mountain Apache Justice Court and the Law and Order Committee; and


**WHEREAS**, the Council has reviewed the Revised Criminal Code carefully, and considered the recommendations and the implications thereof in great detail; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council finds the adoption of the recommendations of the Prosecutor's Office and the Legal Department would greatly improve the administration of public safety and justice for crimes committed on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and that the Revised Criminal Code should be approved as proposed.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Secretary of the Tribal Council to post copies of the proposed Ordinance No. 227, known as the Revised Criminal Code, in each District for at least ten (10) days for public comment before final action by the Tribal Council as required by Article XV, Section 2 of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on February 8, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of FOUR for and ONE against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (h), (i), (q), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
