**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Authorizing expenditure of Rodeo-Chediski account to repair six homes in Cibecue)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and


**WHEREAS**, tribal member Burnette Lupe recently repaired roofs for some of Cibecue White City's residents; and


**WHEREAS**, Mr. Lupe has presented another proposal for roofing repairs and windows for six units in Cibecue for low-income residents; and

**WHEREAS**, members of the Tribal Council concur that this work is essential and should continue.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that expenditure from the Rodeo-Chediski account in the amount of \$30,420.00 for the purposes of six home repairs to be conducted by Burnette Lupe and three other personnel is hereby approved.

The foregoing resolution was on March 8, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
