



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving assistance to the Kinney family)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Kinney family (Andrew Kinney, Gladys Bencomo, Gloria Baha, Stephanie Kinney and Christine Kinney) reported to the Tribal Council this date that their family fry bread stand of many years was destroyed by a fire; and


WHEREAS, the family requests assistance from the Tribe to rebuild the stand; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that rebuilding the stand is in the best interests of the Tribe and recommends the use of FATCO lumber and Housing Authority equipment to cleanup the premises.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that:

1. FATCO is hereby requested to donate hog lumber to assist in the rebuilding of the Kinney family fry bread stand.
2. The Housing Authority is hereby requested to provide equipment to clean up premises of the stand, subject to any applicable federal restrictions on the use of such equipment, if any.

The foregoing resolution was on April 12, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
