**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Termination of Juan Aragon from his position as Superintendent of the Cibecue Community School)**

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is empowered to act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and


**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council has received numerous complaints about Superintendent Aragon that relate to his performance, professionalism and treatment of tribal children, school staff and teachers in a negative light; and


**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council believes that it is in the best interests of the Tribe to terminate and remove Superintendent Aragon from his position and any other future position on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, effective today, April 19, 2006; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council supports and recommends the hiring of tribal members to fill teacher positions and all other school positions as tribal members have been overlooked when filling these positions in the past.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby terminates and removes Juan Aragon from his position as Superintendent of the Cibecue Community School and any other future position on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, effective April 19, 2006, and supports and recommends the hiring of tribal members to fill teacher positions and all other school positions.

The foregoing resolution was on April 19, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
