**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving Budget Continuance for Fiscal Year 2006 for the Central Tribe and Tribal Enterprises)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council previously approved a one-year tribal and enterprise budget for the 2005 fiscal budget year through Resolution Nos. 04-2005-124 and 04-2005-123; and


WHEREAS, as of this date, the Tribal Council, through Budget Committee, is undertaking budget review for the current fiscal year May 1, 2006 through April 30, 2007 to review until budget amendments and other budget matters for Central Tribe and the Enterprises; and


WHEREAS, the budget review is not yet completed and for that reason the Tribal Council adopts this budget continuation resolution to maintain program budgets at the FY 05 level until the review is completed and the amendments approved by the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, this interim budget authority shall exist for sixty (60) days in accordance with following guidelines: (1) spending by enterprises, departments and programs shall not exceed the FY 05 budget level on a per month pro rata basis, unless specifically exempted by previous actions of the Tribal Council; (2) all requests for new positions or pay raises, regardless of funding source, or capital expenditures for vehicles, buildings or other items with a useful life of over one year and of high cost over (\$5,000.00) must receive prior Tribal Council approval; (3) Tribal Enterprises must restrict expenditures to the FY 05 level on a per month pro rata basis; and; (4) for units with Tribal matching funds for operational grants, expenditures shall not exceed the FY 05 budget level on a per month pro rata basis without Tribal Council approval.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache that in accordance with the foregoing restrictions and existing budget controls, it hereby authorizes an interim budget authorization for all Tribal Enterprises and Central Tribe departments for a period of sixty (60) days, beginning on May 1, 2006 through June 30, 2006, at a level not to exceed the Fiscal Year 2005 budget level on a per month pro rata basis.

The foregoing resolution was on April 25, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
