**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving Native Vision Sports and Lifeskills Camp)

WHEREAS, members of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe are duly elected representatives of the people and their respective districts; and among their many concerns are the health and well-being of its Tribal Members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council supports carefully designed research and service projects to evaluate infectious disease and behavioral health problems which exist in the population and to develop appropriate interventions which seek to decrease or alleviate these problems; and


WHEREAS, Johns Hopkins, in partnership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe has agreed to assist in efforts to find ways to raise the self-sufficiency of Indian communities to the highest possible level and to promote and celebrate all that is healthy and positive in the lives of our Native Youth; and

WHEREAS, Native Vision Sports and Lifeskills Camp, scheduled for June 4-6, 2006 in Whiteriver, Arizona, will celebrate the 10th anniversary year of the Camp and the 4th year the White Mountain Apache Tribe has served as host.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache that it hereby authorizes that the Johns Hopkins Center for American Indian Health, in partnership with the NFL Players Association will serve as the coordinating group for the **Native Vision Sports and Lifeskills Camp, June 4-6, 2006 in Whiteriver, Arizona.**

The foregoing resolution was on May 10, 2006, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (j), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
