**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Appointing Frank Johnny Endfield, Jr., as Chief of WMAPD)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe, and to appoint tribal officials and employees; and

**WHEREAS**, the incidence of crime occurring on the lands of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation are of great concern to the Tribal Council and the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution, the Tribal Council did appoint Lieutenant Lincoln Perry as Acting Chief of the White Mountain Apache Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, Frank Johnny Endfield, Jr., has worked as a WMAPD Officer, having received certification from the Arizona Peace Officers Standards and Training Board and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Endfield's certifications have expired and should be renewed should he assume a management position within WMAPD; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds that Lieutenant Perry should be commended for this service and returned to the position of Lieutenant; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council further finds that Frank Johnny Endfield, Jr., is suitable for the position of Chief of WMAPD, subject to a satisfactory background check and full certification by AZPOST and the BIA.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that it hereby appoints Frank Johnny Endfield, Jr., to the position of Chief of WMAPD, subject to a satisfactory background check and full certification by AZPOST and the BIA.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that Lieutenant Lincoln Perry is hereby commended for his services as Acting Chief and returned to the position of Lieutenant.


